



Camp Squeah Food Services COVID-19 Safety Plan

Physical Distancing and Guest Protection

- A record of guests dining at Camp Squeah will be maintained by the main office and will be used for contact tracing should that be required by the Provincial Health Office.
- Dining room tables will be arranged to ensure guests are 6 ft. / 2 m. apart from each other (*Re-Start Step 2-June 15, 2021*). The table arrangement will be updated as PHO directives change.
- Guests will be required to sanitize their hands at our hand sanitizing stations prior to entering the dining area, approaching the food service windows, and entering the beverage station.
- Group sizes per table will be limited to 14 people (*Re-Start Step 2-June 15, 2021*). Group sizes per table will be updated as PHO directives change.
- Upon entering the dining hall, markers have been placed on the floor to demonstrate appropriate distancing from other guests, and to guide guests through food service routes.
- Guests are required to wear masks in the dining hall. Once seated they can remove their masks for dining. Guests will not be permitted to leave their table or wander around the dining hall unless they are going directly to the bathroom or getting their food from the serving window(s). (*Re-Start Step 2-June 15, 2021*) The wearing of masks will be updated as PHO directives change.
- During the summer camping season (July and August 2021) an extra tent will be brought in encourage guests/campers to eat outside in the fresh air and to add more physical space for dining. This action should maximize outdoor eating.

Food Service

- Guests will be asked to refill their own water with the pitchers provided.
- Guests will stack their plates and cutlery and leave them on their tables. Staff will bus the tables once guests have left the dining hall.
- All tables, handheld implements, serving windows, and beverage station will be sanitized in between meal service.
- Washroom surfaces and touch points will be sanitized before and after each meal service. A record will be posted inside washroom doors.
 - o Light switches
 - o Bathroom soap dispensers
 - o Door handles
 - o Bathroom stall door handles
 - o Bathroom counters
 - o Toilets



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- Cafeteria-style food service at our windows will keep guests 6 ft. / 2 m. from the food and the servers. Guests can pick up their plate at a designated pick-up spot once the servers have plated it. *(Re-Start Step 2-June 15, 2021)* Food Service details will be updated as PHO directives change.

Kitchen Environment

- Kitchen staff will be required to self-assess themselves before entering the kitchen for their shift. They will have to confirm their good health via COVID-19 screening questions posted on the delivery doors of the kitchen. If they cannot confirm all the questions, they cannot work their shift, and must notify the Team Leader (Chef or Assistant Chef) immediately. *(Re-Start Step 2-June 15, 2021)*
- Anyone who has arrived from outside of Canada must self-isolate for 14 days and monitor for symptoms. *(Re-Start Step 2-June 15, 2021)*
- Staff will be required to wear masks throughout their shift. *(Re-Start Step 2-June 15, 2021)* The wearing of masks in the kitchen will be updated as PHO directives change.
- Staff will be required to wash their hands between any change of activity (food prep, cleaning, etc.) in the kitchen, and to follow standard Food Safe protocols.
- Any cutting tool for an activity (knife, peelers, paring knives, food processor blades, etc.) must be washed (by the staff who used them) and sanitized before moving on to the next activity. Any other handheld implements are to be put in the dish pit after use.
- Staff will work 2 metres (6 feet) apart from each other whenever possible. *(Re-Start Step 2-June 15, 2021)*
- Staff will be encouraged to wear gloves during food preparation and serving.
- Shared work surfaces will be sanitized after each activity. *(Re-Start Step 2-June 15, 2021)*
- Kitchen common surfaces (handles, switches, etc.) will be sanitized throughout the shift.
- The kitchen will be off-limits to anyone not working their assigned shift. *(Re-Start Step 2-June 15, 2021)*
